

- **Strengthening Case Conversions and Intercepts in India:** Our teams in India are actively working to increase the effectiveness of their interventions, particularly in moving Human Exploitation (HE) cases toward judicial action. A key focus is improving conversion rates—from initial case identification through to arrests, legal proceedings, and just outcomes that include compensation for victims. At the Panitanki station, the team is also prioritizing increased intercept activity, aiming to identify and stop more high-risk movements while ensuring that these cases translate into actionable legal arrests.
- **Expanding Reach and Intelligence Networks in Senegal:** Two new monitoring locations have been identified, resulting in nine interceptions. The team established three new high-value contacts within these locations, strengthening the flow of information and improving identification of vulnerable individuals in transit. Engagement with authorities at these new locations is ongoing and remains key to successful operations. Praise God that one individual responded to the gospel, with follow-up underway to support their ongoing growth and connection to a local church.
- **Expanded Access and Ongoing Investigation in Benin:** Transit monitoring has expanded to a new location, with three individuals safely returned to their families. Praise God that two potential victims responded to the gospel, with follow-up underway to connect them to a local church. The team has been asked by authorities to gather further evidence in an ongoing case to support a potential arrest. Give thanks that registration documents have been received, and pray for the final steps to strengthen formal engagement with authorities.





- Spring Fundraising Campaign: On May 1, we launched a matching gift opportunity and are asking the Lord to open doors and hearts to the mission of setting captives free. We believe we have the most effective means of stopping trafficking, and we advance the gospel every day—sharing the good news with 70% of the potential victims we encounter. Ask the Father to glorify Himself through this work, blessing us with the funds to sustain our existing operations and enlarge our influence so that many more may know the gift of freedom.
- Strategic Partnerships: Our work depends on partnership—with NPOs who take on our mantle and advance the work within their entities, local churches and subcommittees around our stations, police, immigration officials, social workers, prosecutors, policymakers, and partners in prayer and fundraising. This work cannot be done in isolation. Pray that the Lord would guide us, lead us, and unite us with the network of people who together can fight this injustice.
- Online Monitoring: As we scour the internet for fake job opportunities used to lure people into trafficking networks, pray for wisdom, insight, the right tools, and growing influence.
